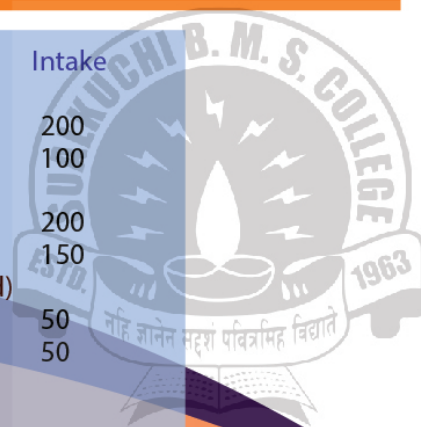

SELF-FINANCING COURSE:

The College has introduced two Self-Financing Courses, namely, Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA) and Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Application (PGDCA) as full-time courses under Gauhati University.

BACHELOR OF COMPUTER APPLICATION (BCA)

Eligibility: Higher Secondary with Mathematics as one of the subjects at the Higher Secondary level is desirable. However students from H.S. Arts and Commerce Streams who have not taken Mathematics in H.S., will have to take up a bridge-course in addition to the normal course in the First Semester of BCA.

Duration: 3 years (Six Semesters) **Student's Intake:** 20

Fees : Rs 10,000/- per Semester, Examination and Registration Fees as rules of Gauhati University. The students will get 20% discount on course fees. The course fees for the 1st semester is 8,000/-

Examination: Examination is conducted by the Gauhati University on the basis of Semester system.

Further Opportunity for Study: Students can study MCA, MSc-IT, MSc (Computer Science), MBA from any other University after completing BCA.

POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN COMPUTER APPLICATION (PGDCA)

Eligibility: Graduate from any discipline.

Duration: 1 year (two Semesters)

Students' Intake: 35

Fees : Rs 5,500/- per Semester, Examination and Registration fees as per rules of Gauhati University.

Examination: Examination is conducted by Gauhati University on the basis of Semester system.

Further Opportunity for Study: Students can study MCA from any University after completing PGDCA.

COMMUNITY COLLEGE SCHEME (UGC-Sponsored)

Community College is a UGC-sponsored scheme aiming at skill development of youth with a high quality of training. SBMS College, Sualkuchi, had already introduced this scheme from the session 2015-16. Students who desire to take admission into the programme of Community College may obtain admission from the College office. The new session starts from August subject to the approval of financial support from UGC.

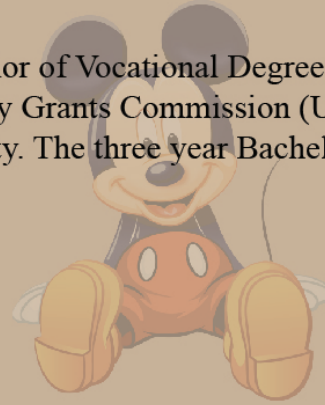

B.Voc. in Animation and Graphic Design

B.Voc. in Fashion Technology



Eligibility: H.S. passed from any stream

These courses are part of National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) and are expected to create employment opportunities for students. The role of vocational education in an economically transforming society is important as it helps in creating job opportunities. The University Grants Commission (UGC) has launched a scheme on skill development as an integrated part of college/university education, qualifying for Bachelor of Vocational (B.Voc.) Degree. The B.Voc. Programme is focussed on universities and colleges providing undergraduate studies which would also incorporate specific job roles and their NOS (National Occupational Standard) along with a broad-based general education.

K.K. HANDIQUI STATE OPEN UNIVERSITY

From 2008-09, a study centre of K.K. Handiqui State Open University has taken functioning in the College campus. The main purpose of this Centre is to promote education to reach the unreached through the Open and Distance Learning system. The courses of this University are open to working people, house-wives, drop-out students.

IDOL CONTACT CENTER

A study centre under IDOL (Institute of Distance & Open Learning) of Gauhati University for pursuing M.A. in the subjects: Assamese, English, Economics, History, Political Science & Philosophy besides Diploma Course was started from the academic session 2009-2010. A Post Graduate Diploma Course in Computer Application (PGDCA) programme under the IDOL is also offered with full facilities of computer laboratory and qualified faculty members.

New admission takes place in the month of August and September.



ADMISSION

1. To be eligible for admission in to the 1st Year of H.S. Course and 1st Year of T.D.C., students will have to pass H.S.L.C. and H.S. Examinations respectively.
2. Admission in to the College is made strictly in order of merit and is governed by the College rules. Decision of the admission committee stands final.
3. Students from Board, Council, and University other than S.E.B.A, A.H.S.E.C. and Gauhati University shall have to produce Migration Certificate at the time of admission.
4. Students passing the qualifying examinations earlier than the current year will have to submit a Gap Certificate from a Govt. Gazetted Officer testifying to his/her activities during the interim period.
5. All documents have to be submitted in soft copies along with online admission forms.
6. The Students must ensure their correct data at the time of online admission.
7. The Students should furnish the details of Bank Account i.c. Bank Name, Branch Name, Account Number, IFS Code, Mobile Number. Once the data is submitted by the students, the same cannot be changed during their tenure in the College otherwise they will be deprived from the Govt. beneficiary schemes.
8. The Students must provided their data incorporating the following points in Admission Form: Name of District, Name of Student, Class in which admitted, Stream in which admitted, Father's name, Gender, Caste, Whether PWD, Domicile State, Bank Account details and Mobile Number.
9. The Students must furnish any one of following supporting documents to prove their domicile of Assam like - PRC/Voter Identity Card of self or parent/NRC of self or parent / ADHAR Card of self or parent / BPL Card of family/Birth Certificate issued by Registrar of Birth and Death/Pass-Port of self or parent.
10. The Self-financing Courses and Streams will not be included under fee waiver scheme.
11. Hostel mess dues will not be a part of fee waiver scheme.
12. There will be a common software to prevent blocking of seats in more than one college by a single student depriving other aspirants and also to check wastage of Govt.fund.

GENERAL RULES

1. Ragging:

Ragging is considered as a criminal offence and is strictly prohibited in the College campus. The College authority has the power to register FIRs whenever such misconduct of ragging come to the notice. The authority will rusticate the offender if allegation is proved genuine

2. Uniform:

Wearing uniform in all sorts of academic and social functions of the College is mandatory. Violation of the rule is an offence liable to be punished. The details of the uniform are:

- (i) Boys: Sky blue shirt & navy blue formal trouser.
- (ii) Girls: Sky blue salwar with white dupatta.

Winter dress: For both boys and girls sky blue sweater: Jeans jacket is not allowed

3. Election:

Students' Union Election is held once in an academic session. There is a specific date for this in the Academic Calendar. The following norms, as framed by the honorable Supreme Court of India, are to be strictly followed:

Under / graduate students between ages 17-22 years are eligible to contest Students' Union Election as per the verdict of Supreme Court dated 22.09.2016 relating to the case of Kerala University vs. Council Principal of Education.

Under graduate students between ages 17-22 years may contest election. This age range may be appropriately relaxed in the case of professional college, where the course often ranges between 4-5 years.

Although, the committee would refrain from prescribing any particular minimum marks to be attained by the candidate, the candidate should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election.

The candidate should have attained the minimum percentage of attendance as prescribed by the University or 75% of attendance, whichever is higher.

4. Attendance:

Attendance in general as well as tutorial classes is strictly compulsory. A student must not attend less than 65% of the lecture delivered in each subject to be eligible for appearing in the University or Council Examination. A student having less than 60% attendance will be treated as either non-collegiate or discollegiate, as the case may be. A non-collegiate student will have to pay a fine of Rs.100 per subject for appearing in the examination. A student failing to attend classes for 25 days at a stretch from the date of commencement of classes shall forfeit his/her seat.

GENERAL RULES

6. Examination:

Apart from the final examination conducted by A.H.S.E.C., and G.U., the Unit Tests, Sessional Tests are held under the supervision of the College authority as notified in the College prospectus

The Assam Higher Secondary Education Council has decided to break up the course of study at the stage +2 into two parts.

- (i) 1st Year Examination at the end of the 1st year course.
- (ii) Final year examination at the end of the 2nd year course. The examinations are conducted according to the dates fixed by the Council.
- (iii) From the session 2011-2012, Guahati University has divided the three year degree course into six Semesters. The College authority has decided to send the mark sheets of the Terminal Examination/ Unit Test to respective guardians by post. The Terminal Examination/ Unit test of H.S and TDC students are held conveniently after serving prior notifications to that effect.

3. Procedure:

 - (b) After “sign up” click on “log in” button and fill up the application form.
 - (c) Upload your photo.
 - (d) After successfully filling up all the form the PDF of filled in application form will be generated.
4. Visit the College website from time to time to know your candidature and other terms and conditions.

CAMPUS FACILITY

INTERNET: College has availed broadband internet connection for better surfing of internet in the college campus itself. To facilitate information a new website titled www.sbmscollege.org.in has also been registered in the internet. An internet cafe is available in the College library.

FREE WI-FI ZONE: It is a real boon for students, researchers and teachers that Govt. of Assam has recently provided necessary fund to create Wi-Fi zone in the College campus. The Wi-Fi facility is free and has been recently updated with improved technology.

LIBRARY: S.B.M.S. College provides excellent library facilities within the College campus. There are two types of libraries in the College campus:

(i) Central Library (ii) Departmental Library. Students may borrow books from the Libraries against library cards. They may access various newspapers and journals in the spacious reading room of the Central Library. At present there are near about 30,000 books including some valuable reference books and 156 peer-reviewed journals which facilitate the students offering Major/Honours in different subjects. Mention may be made of the numerous volumes of encyclopedias and Classical Literature which are of much value for both the students as well as the teachers. The Central Library is fully digitalized and it has been renovated recently.

Computers have been installed in the Central Library for the smooth functioning of the issue and record-keeping of books.

Working hours of the Library: 9.30am to 4.30pm

Number of cards issued to students : H.S. Classes -- 2 each
T.D.C. Classes -- 2 each

LABORATORY: Satisfactory laboratory facilities are available to the H.S. and Degree Science students. The Department of Education also has a well-equipped laboratory of its own for conducting its practicals.

GENERATOR: Two high-power generator sets have been installed in the College campus, which make up for the shortfall of electricity in the campus.

CANTEEN: As nobody is allowed to leave the College campus during the office hours, there is canteen facility for each and every member of the College fraternity.

DRINKING WATER: Local NGO, Agragami Yuva Mancha, extended philanthropic service by providing the Institution with pure drinking water and running water to the Science laboratories and common rooms. A water-cooler with RO facility has also been installed in the campus.



COLLEGE PRINTING UNIT: A College Printing Unit caters to printing of different materials such as question papers of the Sessional Examinations, etc.

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS: The College has installed 10 fire extinguishers to ensure the safety of the college Campus.

ALTERNATIVE ENERGY SOURCES: The Institution is also proud to avail of an alternative source viz. solar power which has been recently financed by the UGC. Solar panels have been installed which produce nearly 23MW of power. Besides there is also a portable generator to supply uninterrupted power daily during periods of load-shedding

SPORTS FACILITIES: The Institution has procured a considerable number of sports equipment for both indoor and outdoor games. In addition to those, new infrastructure such as a basketball and a lawn tennis court have been developed inside the college Campus so as to popularize these sports among the students.

CAMPUS INTERVIEWS: The Career Counseling and Guidance Cell of the College organizes various campus interviews every year in collaboration with numerous recruitment agencies and private companies.

MULTIMEDIA CLASSROOMS: There are altogether seven multimedia classrooms along with a virtual classroom in the College.

PHOTOSTAT: Photostat facilities are available in the College. Students are allowed to avail this facility at a concessional rate.

LANGUAGE LABORATORY: A Language Laboratory has been functioning in the Institution where students get the chance to improve their vocabulary and writing skill through one-to-one contact with the instructor. There are altogether (1+6) computer sets in the laboratory, all having LAN connections.

YOGA CLASSES : Yoga classes are mandatory for all the students of the college . There are provisions for yoga classes by expert trainers for students of the Institution on rotation basis every Saturday.



SUPPORT SERVICE

1) Internal Quality Assurance Cell: The establishment of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) by SBMS College is a major step in pushing long-term quality standards. IQAC is a significant administrative body that is responsible for all quality matters. It is the prime responsibility of IQAC to initiate, plan and supervise various activities that are necessary to enhance the quality of education imparted in the College. IQAC of the College completed two NAAC assessment rounds so far and is working vigorously to uplift the quality of teaching learning process along with research activities of faculties of different Departments. The Cell is in the charge of preparing Annual Quality Assurance Reports (AQAR) of the College the describe the future course of action and what has been done to materialise planned goals for growth of the Institution.

2) Anti -Ragging Cell: It is a matter of pride that the Institution has recorded zero rate of ragging over the years. However, to follow the order of Honorable Supreme Court, vis-à-vis guidelines of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), and State Government, the College has an active Anti- Ragging Cell, the objective of which is to sort out grievances of the students, if any. The Cell acts promptly, after getting any information of ragging in and around the College campus. The Cell comprises of members as per the guidelines of UGC, headed by the Principal. The Cell has the power to take stern action against any misdoer.

3) Grievance and Redressal Cell: Grievance Cell is constituted for redressal of the grievances of faculty, staff & students. Meetings of the Cell are conducted regularly to examine the grievances of faculty, staff, and students, and the Cell proposes necessary measures to be taken by the Administration to resolve the same.

4) Career and Counselling Cell: Career Guidance & Counselling Cell develops a student's competencies in self-knowledge, educational and occupational exploration & career planning. Specific inputs are given to the students by the Cell regarding career choices mapped and aligned to their passions/interests. Career Counselling helps the students to fulfil their career goals and serve as the bridge between their College experience and employments helping them apply what they have learned.

5) Placement Cell: The Placement Cell is an active platform to provide placement and internship facilities to the students. A number of students from all the disciplines are benefitted through the Placement Cell. Here is a glimpse of student - beneficiaries mentioned in the following table:

6) Women Cell: There is a 'Women Cell' in the College comprising of faculty members of both the Arts & Science streams as well as members of the Library staff. The Cell takes active part in awareness programme on issues like problems on women, women empowerment and gender sensitization.

7) Anti Sexual Harassment Cell: The Women Cell was framed by SBMS College following the recommendations by The United Nations Committee on the elimination of discrimination against women. It has conducted a workshop-cum-sensitization programme on the issue of sexual harassment at workplace. As per the guidelines of Honourable Supreme Court & UGC, Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition & Redressal) Act 2013, an Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell was constituted with a view to provide healthy and congenial atmosphere to all the students and staff members

8) NCC & NSS: The College opened the National Service Scheme (NSS) with a strength of 100 student volunteers. Over the years, the Unit has rendered commendable services in the College and community level. It has also represented in the various state-level and national-level programmes held at different institutions in and outside the state. It is worth mentioning that one of our volunteers was adjudged the best volunteer at a community level camp held at LCB College, Guwahati. The NCC (National Cadet Corps) wing of the College has earned distinction in the entire locality.

SUPPORT SERVICE

At present the Unit has a total strength of 108 cadets. The NCC unit of College has the distinction of being the largest unit of One Assam Battalion. Many cadets of the College NCC Unit participate regularly in the various camps held in the different places of the country.

9)Welfare Fund: The College has a well maintained Student Welfare Fund for providing financial help to the poor and deserving students. This fund also runs a 'Book Bank' and students are hugely benefited by this.

10)Awards: Two Awards, namely: (a) Late Subhrendu Baishya Memorial Award (b) Best Reader Award have been instituted from academic year 2015-16. A high-level committee headed by the Principal select deserving students. (a) Late Subhrendu Baishya Memorial award: This Award (a certificate and rupees five thousand in cash) is given to the newly enrolled student of the First Semester (Arts/Science) securing the highest percentage of marks in Higher Secondary Examination. This award is sponsored by Budram Gas Service, Sualkuchi,(b) Best Reader Award: Best reader (Library)Award is given in the memory of Late Nityananda Baishya of Sualkuchi. It is meant for the student as reader of maximum number of library books within an academic year. This award is sponsored by Prof. Badan Barman of Library Science Dept., Gauhati University.

11) Co-Curricular Guidance: This is an arrangement for co-curricular guidance for students. The college organizes short and long term student-oriented programmes to build up their careers in the non-traditional ways. The Study Circle of the college also organizes Seminars, Workshops, etc. to fulfill their need.

12) Excursion, Educational Tours and Awareness Programmes: SBMS College facilitates excursion and educational tours for students every year.

13)Gym & Fitness Centre: This well-equipped physical exercise center provides training to the interested students and ex-students to keep them healthy at the charge of a nominal amount of fees. At present there are two physical instructors who provide guidance to the students in the Fitness Center in the morning and evening.

14)Health Unit: The College has a health unit for the student as well as teachers. A local doctor from the P.H.E extends valuable help towards the Institution.

15) Hostel Facilities: With the fund received from the UGC, the College has constructed a 3-storeyed girls' hostel for the girl students coming from distant areas.

16)Scholarship: Government of Assam offers scholarship under various schemes to the students. Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Minority students usually get scholarship.

17) College Magazine/Wall Magazine/Newsletter:The College magazine "ARUNAV" and wall magazine "ANUBHUTI" are the mediums for development of literary and other potentialities of the students. Various articles, creative stories, poems,etc. contributed by students & teachers and also reports of activities held in the College are published in the magazines and the "NEWSLETTER".

18) Study Circle: A College Study Circle has been formed with a view to bringing out talents of the students in literary and others fields. Every bonafide student of the College is the member of this Circle. The aim of this Circle is basically to expose the talent from the students.

19) Virtual Classroom: A state of the art Virtual Classroom was facilitated in the College in the year 2015. This new facility supports real-time streaming of audio-visual media thereby connecting other institutions for knowledge and experience sharing. The Virtual Classroom is equipped with technologically enabled teaching aids which have helped various departments to impart teaching in a more innovative way.

20)Digital Library: An initiative has been undertaken to avail the reference books and journals indispensable for the academic milieu in digital platform. To keep pace with the rapidly changing knowledge sharing trend in the modern world, SBMS College has begun to digitize some of the most important and essential reference study materials for the students and faculties. Since e-books and e- journals can be accessed through all communication devices, the Digital Library is expected to serve the students and the teaching fraternity alike in the times to come. A digital Kiosk has been set up inside the library campus for instant exploration of available resources.



HOSTEL ACCOMODATION

SBMS College has started a new era in education by adding a newly constructed 3 storeyed full functional women's hostel. Hostel life not only develops the spirit of healthy competition, but also teaches lessons in mutual cooperation, adaptation, tolerance, and mutual respect. Indians have a tradition from times immemorial to go out from native place/homes to get education as to learn other skills. Thus a hostel provides an atmosphere of home-away-from-home. The hostel campus of the Institution has excellent infrastructure providing a comfortable space to its residents, made to be safe in terms of health and hygiene as well as a wonderful academic atmosphere to the meritorious and needy students coming from far/off places. Initially, the hostel facility was available only to limited numbers of female students. A committee comprising of the Principal and members of the teaching staff look after the functioning of the hostel affairs.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Hostel seats are limited and admission is strictly based on need and merit of the aspirant.
- Only outstation students are eligible for admission.
- Govt. Reservation Rules will be applicable for securing Hostel admission.
- Hostel accommodation (room) can be changed by the management if they find it necessary at any given point of time.
- Students are prohibited from giving shelter to any other student/outsider in the rooms. In case of any unauthorized shelter, the student will be liable to disciplinary action.
- Students should handle hostel equipment, furniture, mess property carefully and not abuse or tamper with it. If found guilty, applicable fine will be charged by the hostel management.
- Hostel authorities will not be responsible for any loss of money, jewellery or personal belongings of any boarders. Boarders are advised not to keep any cash/jewellery or any costly items in their rooms.

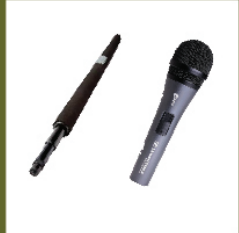
- Annual fees: Rs 10,000 which includes seat rent, electricity, maintenance of support staff, etc.

Audio Recording and Post Production Studio

Audio recording and post production is a very productive career option. Apart from film industry, a person trained in audiography and sound post production can earn meaningful livelihood in the domain of Animation, Television Commercial, Video Journalism, Live events, Music industry etc. Audio recording and mixing is an integral part of Animation filmmaking. Aiming to create proper infrastructure and ambience for imparting practice oriented training, SBMS College, Sualkuchi has established a dedicated studio for Audio mixing and Post Production in aegis of Department of Animation and Graphic Design. The studio boasts of the following Audio Hardware and Recording Set ups.



1) Yamaha 01V96i Digital Mixing Console: This set up offers 16 in/ 16 out live audio streaming at 96 kHz for multitrack recording and playback. It contains precision 100 mm motor faders and high resolution REV-X reverbs and is loaded with I/O expansion slot that accepts mini –YGDAI cards. This state of the art machine is compatible with both Windows and Macintosh versions of 01V96i editor for offline and online data management.



2) Omni and Supercardioid Microphone : The studio is equipped with Omni and Short range shotgun microphone that boasts an accurate sound while providing superb noise reduction. Omni microphone is handy live recording and events while the Shotgun microphone will help in the production of location recording, Foley and Voice Over.

3) Portable Recorder and Telescopic Boom Rod: The audio production department has procured a portable multitrack recorder and a long range telescopic rod for enhancing sound recording and design capabilities.

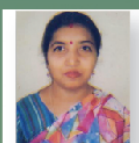
